
Travel Route to Batam via Singapore and Jakarta


CDIO ASIAN REGIONAL MEETING (ARM) 2025 at Batam State Polytechnic



Here's how to visit the CDIO ARM 2025 event at Batam State Polytechnic.



There are two main routes to reach Batam. The first one is via Singapore and the second is via Jakarta.



If you're planning to travel via Singapore, the first step is to land at the Changi International Airport.



Then you will need to continue your journey by ferry. There are two main ferry terminals in Singapore, which are Tanah Merah Terminal and HarbourFront Terminal.



If you want the fastest transfer from the airport, Tanah Merah Terminal could be convenient. It's closer to Changi International Airport and is accessible by taxi or public bus. However, it has fewer ferry schedule options.



If you prefer flexible and reliable schedules, HarbourFront Terminal could be the best option. It's located in central Singapore, easily accessible by MRT, and offers more frequent ferry departures to Batam.





After choosing your departure ferry terminal, you will be directed to Batam Center Port as your primary destination. Once you have arrived, our team will be there to pick you up at the harbour.



If you're traveling through Jakarta, land at the Soekarno-Hatta International Airport.





Then continue with a domestic flight to the Hang Nadim International Airport. Once you have arrived, our team will pick you up at the airport.
